# Memphis Rise Academy Board Meeting Minutes April 30, 2018

### **Head of School Update**

Enrollment is on hold right now because of the end of the school year coming up shortly. Career Day has been set for May 30 from 1:30-4:00. EOC testing is currently in progress in the high school, while TCAP testing is currently in progress in the middle school. Graduation activities have been set fir June 15/16, and graduation will be held at Lindenwood Christian Church. The amounts of grant money to be received from Poplar Foundation, Hyde Foundation, and Pyramid Peak were discussed. There was a discussion (and board approval) of hiring Ben Fox from Adams & Reese on retainer to represent RISE in the event legal services are needed. The need to locate a second parent as a potential board member was discussed.

#### Finance/Real Estate Update

The March forecast was decreased by \$41K mainly due to increased spending on supplies/materials. The cash balance is projected to be around \$48K at the end of May, and over \$50K at the end of June. Current enrollment was adjusted to 436 students for the end of the school year. The ending cash balance is strong for the end of the 2017/2018 fiscal year.

## **Legislative Update**

Victor Evans provided a legislative update that included a discussion about the charter facilities grant fund being funded and working on changing the formula for high cost (i.e. special ed) students.
