

TUITION FREE, ENROLLMENT BY LOTTERY

We are a tuition-free charter school with a mission of educating every student, regardless of background or special needs. We accept applications from all interested families.

SMALL SCHOOL, BIG MISSION

We are able to accept 112 students into each of our grade levels, making our student-teacher ratio 15:1. We pride ourselves upon meeting our students where they are on an individual level, starting in 6th grade, to continuously identify their strengths and challenges.

FREQUENT FAMILY COMMUNICATION

With weekly progress reports including a personalized note to each family, consistent communication from teachers and administrators, and an organization designed to give families a voice, Memphis Rise Academy is committed to maintaining an open dialogue with its families regarding their child's progress.

LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST MEMPHIS COMMUNITY

Memphis Rise Academy is committed to serving the Northeast Memphis community and is located near the intersection of Covington Pike and Raleigh Lagrange Road.

DAILY TUTORING

Our teachers lead daily tutoring groups, called Focus, to give students more help in high-need areas.

MORE IMPACT

Memphis Rise students will receive six core classes, including double the minutes in literacy and math than a traditional public school model, a small-group tutoring period, and an enrichment activity such as music, athletics, technology, and more. Students in our high school are exposed to a wide variety of college preparatory elective options.

We believe in college preparation for all students, including support from our post-secondary team on applying to college and finding financial aid. However, we also know that other opportunities, like vocational or technical education, military options, or gap year internships might better fit out students' needs.
